- The minutes of the January 18, 2022 Regular Session and February 1, 2022 Special Session were approved as presented.
- Mr. Andrew Jones, High School Principal, introduced Rensselaer Central’s Leading Girls Basketball Scorer Jesse Ringen with 1257 career points and the Regional Championship Wrestling Team with two (2) wrestlers advancing to the State competition. Mr. Jones also updated the board on programs and courses offered at the High School.
- Mr. Greg Michael, Middle School Principal, presented to the board information on the NWEA and ILearn tests that the Middle School students are required to take.
- Superintendent Craig informed the board that the Energy Savings Project completed at Van School is saving the corporation \$50,000 per year. Bids for concrete tennis courts were received and work on the pool will begin as soon as swimming is finished.
